The Croatian Scholarship Fund is a non-profit organization that provides university scholarships to students in Croatia and Bosnia & Herzegovina.

Each and every year since 1991 "Big Joe", Zlatko Vasilj has held golf tournaments in the Sacramento area. This year was his 28th Annual Tournament! It was held on September 15, 2018 at Morgan Creek Golf Course in Roseville.

So graciously, Big Joe has donated the proceeds to charity. Early on, he donated funds to the Croatian Refugees and for the last 12 or more years he has provided very substantial donations to the Croatian Scholarship Fund.

Initially, Joe and his son Marko began the monumental task of organizing and holding the tournament. The father and son team had great tournament success, eventually with a unbelievable turnout of up to 155 players, and they soon decided to make it an annual event. Organizing a golf event is no easy task, sharing the workload obviously makes it easier. Unfortunately, in 2013, Marko was diagnosed with cancer and passed away only six short months later. Since Marko's death, Joe's nephews Dennis & Nick, have been instrumental in helping keep the tournament going, primarily in remembrance and as a wonderful tribute to Joe's late son and their cousin Marko. Over nearly three decades, golf changed considerably, fewer courses and players are available, yet Joe and his nephews continue to gather nearly 100 players, this year and last having 96. Joe, Zlatko, so selflessly continues the huge job of holding the tournament and also continues to annually donate \$10,000 to the Croatian Scholarship Fund. We at CSF are very honored and are very thankful to receive

this tremendous donation from Big Joe. Over the years Joe has allowed many students to achieve their dreams of obtaining their higher education. CSF is indebted to Big Joe for his continued hard work and dedication. The world needs more people like Big Joe, who give so tirelessly to benefit those who need it most. We at CSF congratulate Joe and thank him from the bottom of our hearts. ■
