

Valentina Kišan

Valentina lives in Gornji Desinec, near Zagreb, with her unemployed mother, 16-year old brother and her grandmother. In September 2018 the family experienced a deep tragedy. Her father suffered a major stroke and did not survive.

Valentina was a straight-A student in high school. She demonstrated strong leadership qualities in school and volunteer work. She competed and won top awards in school and County competitions in Croatian language, biology and German language.

Mihaela Vlahović

Mihaela lives in Gornja Stubica, near Zagreb, with her parents and five brothers. Her father is a war veteran and works as a driver, mother is unemployed. All five brothers are attending school; two are at university, one in high school and two in elementary school.

Mihaela was a straight-A student in high school. She competed in number of local and County competitions in biology, physics, chemistry, mathematics and Croatian language. She often won 2nd place in these competitions. In 2015 and 2016, Mihaela was Croatia's top winner in Martial Arts.

Antonio Novak

Antonio lives in Selnici with his parents and three sisters. His younger sister has special needs. His father works and mother is a housewife. At early age Antonio developed a love for geography. He graduated from high school with honors and was involved in national competitions in geography, mathematics, chemistry, English and Croatian language. He is active in his church and volunteers in a County Down Syndrome organization.

Karla Buhovac

Karla lives in Mostar, Bosna & Hercegovina with her parents, younger sister age 15 and two brothers ages 10 and 7. While both parents work, it is a financial struggle for them given the family size and limited income.

Matija Lesković – PhD Student

One of Miljenko Grgich Endowment Program's goals is to support academic excellence and scholarly work in the wine industry in Croatia. Last year, CSF provided financial support to Mr. Matija Lesković to start his doctorate studies in enology research at Stellenbosch University in South Africa. A few years ago, we stepped in again and funded his internship at a winery in Napa Valley. We are very pleased that Mr. Lesković is excelling in his research at Stellenbosch and promoting Croatian wines in South Africa.

Croatian Student Organizes Tasting of His Motherland's Wines

"The first-ever wine tasting event of Croatian wines in South Africa was held at Stellenbosch University's Department of Viticulture and Oenology last week. The evening was made possible through the initiative of Matija Lesković a Croatian student who has been working towards his doctorate in oenology at Stellenbosch University since mid-2018.

Croatian wines were tasted, while Lesković also gave an overview of the country itself and grape varieties being grown.

Mr. Lesković shared with us that major South African importers and wine distributors are now considering importing Croatian wines to South Africa, which will be the first time in history."

Medical Students internship at Cleveland Medical Center



This February, the Croatian community lost one of its best, Mr. Sveto Olujić. He was a generous and selfless man loved by all who knew him. We are very saddened by this loss. The family requested donations to the Croatian Scholarship Fund in lieu of flowers. They have asked that the funds be used to help medical students in Croatia. To that end, CSF has collaborated with the American Association of Croatian Professionals (ACAP) and the worldfamous Cleveland Clinic Medical Center – specifically Dr. Mario Skugor and Dr. Steven Pavletić as well as the University of Zagreb Medical School.

In Sveto's memory, two medical students from University of Zagreb Medical School were selected and interned at the Cleveland Clinic Medical Center this past summer. Antun Zvonimir Kovać interned in the Cardiovascular Medicine Department and Ana Smajo in the Rheumatic & Immunology Desease Department.

Should funds become available as a result of this project, it may serve as a model for future collaboration and internship experiences for other students attending the University of Zagreb Medical School.

We are pleased to share comments on the students' internship experiences:

Ana Smajo - *I am thankful for the* opportunity that the staff, doctors and the fund have provided me. My time in the exchange program has been not only highly educational, but also very eye-opening and rewarding. This experience has taught me a great deal about American medical education, healthcare, research, innovation, and culture. I hope to use what I learned to inform my future career in medicine and potentially collaborate with American ίσατε sveiki atv professionals.

Antun Zvonimir Kovać - I achieved my goal of getting hands-on experience and practice. I renewed and widened my knowledge and applied it in clinical rounds and academic discussion. I have met a lot of interesting people and exchanged experiences with the medical colleagues. This has all helped in my formation as a young doctor.


