CSF Fundraising Campaign

The Covid 19 pandemic has been a struggle for most of us and CSF is no exception. As a result, CSF had to cancel its two major fundraising events this year, the Gala Dinner in Sacramento and the Golf Tournament in the SF Bay Area. These two events generate approximately \$75,000 annually. Those funds are critical for the support of our students and for the administration of our program.

At the same time that CSF experienced a decline in funds, the number of students applying for scholarships increased. Many of the excellent Croatian applicants had to be turned away. In spite of our limited budget, CSF was able to accept 18 new students into the program.

To help cover the shortfall and to pay for the additional scholarships, CSF launched a Fundraising Campaign. In addition to letters and personal appeals, CSF reached out to the community through a "gofundme" appeal.

As of the writing of this article, CSF raised \$32,020.00. We appreciate the numerous donors who responded to our Fundraising Campaign. Although it does not replace all of the funds lost to CSF due to the crisis, it is encouraging to see such a significant response. Many people are hurting and we know that donations mean more now in these difficult times.

Ana was raised by a single mother and lives with her older brother and her grandmother. Her family has struggled, surviving on whatever temporary jobs they could find. Recently, their search for work has been hindered by Covid 19 and loss of even more jobs in Croatia. Since her mother was often at work, Ana formed a strong attachment with her grandmother who was the impetus for Ana choos-

ing nursing, in that her grandmother who cared for the family for so many years, is now older and Ana wants to be able to care for her. Ana also hopes to increase her chances for a better future.

In preparation for nursing, and also out of sheer altruism, she has

taken part in humanitarian programs collecting food and hygiene supplies for those in need and assisting people with special needs. Fun time is spent with her friends and movies which she loves. She looks forward to her studies as the University and working towards her goal of "helping and caring about people".

What Ana loves about Croatia is its culture, music, archeology, sports, history, language, its age and uniqueness. What she would like to see changed in Croatia is more jobs. During the last year, the Corona Virus required that she study online. That was difficult and Ana is excited about joining her fellow students and professors in a classroom setting.

In closing, Ana said that CSF is unaware of what it means to the young people and their families. "It's beautiful what they (CSF donors) do..."




Tatjana Grgich: 1928 - 2020

Croatian Scholarship Fund Endowment

CSF is exploring ways to cement its financial status at times like these. We encourage people to give what they can in donations. But single-payment donations aren't the only option a CSF supporter has. Like most established charitable organizations, CSF has an endowment program. This program is monitored by CSF Executive Board and the Investment Committee. Endowment may consist of gifts of money, stocks, real properties or other forms of monetary value. The principal amount of the gift is never invaded, its interest is assigned to scholarships for Croatian Students living and attending universities in Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Thus the gift provides scholarships into perpetuity. These scholarships can be named in memory of donors, families or other entities, they can also specify the area of study or region of Croatia or Bosnia and Herzegovina. The endowments will carry their original identification and forever carry donor's legacy.

Currently CSF oversees two endowment funds, Miljenko Grgich Endowment Scholarship Fund and Cumbelich Family Endowment Scholarship. We would like to expand this program and encourage our supporters to consider

the Croatian Scholarship Fund Endowment as an alternative vehicle for your charitable funds.
