Marko Galic is from Split attending the University of Zadar in a Master's program. He has recently been the center of attention, not only for his academic pursuits and publications but as a subject of news stories. Marko was twice on national TV in November 2020 for primetime news and interviewed in January 2021 on regional

news. He has also been featured in Slobodna Dalmatia, the leading newspaper in Dalmatia county.

The young student who has been the center of this media buzz is an exceptional athlete and aspiring psychologist whose enthusiasm cannot be contained. In March 2020, when the world was facing a shutdown due to a pandemic, Marko surveyed over a thousand Croatians inquiring of their relationship between COVID-19 and mental health. The premise was that the pandemic which

led to changes in everyday life affected people's psychophysical health. The result of this inquiry was an in depth study published in Frontiers in Psychology November 2020. The title is: COVID-19 Related Knowledge and Mental Health: Case of Croatia.

Frontiers in Psychology is the largest journal in its field publishing rigorously peerreviewed research across the psychological sciences. It put Croatia in the spotlight and generated much interest in the press. The publication made Marko one of the youngest scientist published in this prestigious journal.

Our stellar CSF student was also honored by the Department of Psychology for his Exceptional Participation in Extracurricula Activity. In addition, another of his articles has been accepted to be published as a book chapter. He has also turned his attention to a study related to Dalmatia and its people by looking at why young people select seafaring professions which are proven to be stressful and dangerous. The focus is on the personality traits and personal health. This research will be looking at Zadar's, and hence Dalmatia's, seafaring tradition and Marko and his associates are the only academics studying maritime psychology. So far, one scientific article about future seafarers has been published in Društvena istraživanja, the leading journal for social sciences in Croatia.

Another of Marko's achievements is a first place at national championship in middle distance triatholone. He has also been offered a PhD post at University of Zagreb even before completing his Master's Degree. And for his Master thesis he is collecting data for occupational stress in firefighters.

CSF is fortunate to have recognized Marko's talents early in his career and happy that he is part of our large family. Bravo Marko... you are a tribute to CSF and to Croatia.
