### CSF receives two new Endowment Funds

We are grateful to Mr. Damir Rados and Tony Ujdur for establishing Endowment Funds with CSF. The funds will provide additional scholarships to academically gifted and financially deserving students attending universities in Croatia and Bosnia & Hercegovina and these funds will continue in perpetuity.

#### Mr. Damir Radoš:

Dragica Krog Radoš Scholarship Fund was established by Mr. Damir Radoš in the memory of his deceased mother Mrs. Dragica Krog Radoš who was born in Zagreb, Croatia and died at the age of 97 in Burlingame.

Dragica began performing at an early age at the Croatian National Theatre filling a need for children's roles in operas and operettas and singing in children's choir. She continued her career with emphasis on operettas and drama acting until the events of the WWII ended her professional career, causing her to leave Zagreb and eventually settle in California.

Dragica loved her homeland and continued to promote her native Croatia before, during and after the Liberation War. She continued with philanthropic work in the area of theatre

and drama including children of war. Fifty years after leaving Croatia, she was able to return to her beloved Zagreb, which she visited yearly until the age of 94. The Dragica Krog Radoš Scholarship Fund will provide scholarships to students majoring in Theatre Arts and Music Academy at the University of Zagreb. CSF is honored and grateful to Mr. Radoš for his generous donation.

#### **Mr. Tony Ujdur Endowment:**

Tony was one of the CSF founders and contributed to the success and longevity of the organization for 30 years. He was involved in CSF leadership, served on the Executive and Advisory Boards, and contributed generously with financial support. He started sponsoring students from the

### Letter from a Graduate



Josip Vlaić, MD, Children's Hospital, Zagreb

I was born on September 11, 1982 in Šibenik. I lived in Drniš, but because of the war, I went to Split and then to Zagreb. I entered the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb in 2001, and then received a CSF scholarship. Even though it was a long time ago, I remember being happy because that was when I bought my first computer. I graduated from

university in 2007, and specialized in orthopedics at the Zagreb Children's Disease Clinic in 2015. Since then, I have been working as a doctor in the department of orthopedics.

As a pediatric orthopedist, I work with the smallest to older children, and my job offers me many opportunities to experience someone's happiness, but unfortunately sometimes also sadness. Therefore, the work can sometimes be exhausting because it requires complete commitment to small patients. Additionally, I acquired knowledge about diseases and injuries of children's and adolescent's knees, ... and I got my doctorate in the field of reconstruction of knee ligaments. I am involved in the work of several professional associations of doctors, and I actively participate in numerous domestic and international orthopedic symposia and congresses.

On a personal level, my wish is to have a peaceful and fulfilling life that includes enough time for my family with whom I share all my happiness.

Once again, I would like to express my deep gratitude to you for everything you have done for us, provided us with support and greatly facilitated the already demanding and thorny path through the first academic year.








I believe that all participation in conferences, publication of two articles, publication of two chapters in books; as well as the first and third place in her age category at the Croatian Triathlon


