Dragica Krog Radoš Scholarship Fund

Mr. Damir Radoš established this endowment in memory of his mother Dragica Krog Radoš. Last year a first class of 4 students were selected into the program and CSF is in the process of selecting a new group of students for this year. The scholarships are offered to students majoring in Theatre Arts and Music Academy at the University of Zagreb.

CSF is also supporting a student, Ivan Galić, who is in a PhD program at the University of Sarajevo. This is an "Excellence Program" supporting individuals or students contributing greatly to the field of Music or Theatre Arts. A short profile on Ivan is included here.

Graduate student at University of Sarajevo Music Academy Ph.D. program

CSF is pleased to announce that it has honored Ivan Galić, an amazing Croatian pianist, with their Excellence Award to support his PhD program at the University of Sarajevo. Ivan will attend Music Academy of University of Sarajevo for the next three years to work on his doctorate degree in the class of distinguished professor Ruben Dalibaltayan.

Born in 1994 in Gorica, Ivan studied at the Academy of Music in Zagreb, and then at the Franz Liszt University in Weimar, his professors included Ljubomir Gašparović, Grigory Gruzman, Christian Wilm Müller, Balazs Szokolay, Imre Rohmann and Ruben Dalibaltayan. In 2009, he won the Chopin Golden Ring Competition in Ljubljana, followed by significant prizes and musical competitions in Zagreb, Berlin, San Dona di Piave, Hamburg and Tbilisi. He has performed as a soloist with Mostar Symphony Orchestra, Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra and chamber orchestras of Zagreb Music Academy and Franz Liszt University in Weimar, as well as performances throughout Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Germany, Italy, France and South Korea.

Ivan Galić, prominent musician in his own right, has paid homage in his work, to Franz Schubert, Johannes Brahms and the modern works composed by Ivo Maček, a prominent Croatian musician of the 20th century, of which Ivan Galić says:

"Ivo Maček's works, too little known but of remarkable quality, are worth listening to on my album. Artistically speaking,

such works are deeply rooted in the music tradition of late Romanticism. They show a composer with great personality and extraordinary music qualities, completely devoted to his vocation. It is very important for me to pay homage to one of the best Croatian piano composers.

Letter from the President

This year I was elected President of CSF after 15 years on the CSF Board of Directors, serving as secretary and later as treasurer. It is a great honor and a daunting challenge to be following Marijana Pavić as CSF's President.

Marijana Pavić leaves the role as President, where she served from 2010 to 2023, and now she is the Director in charge of student outreach. As president she oversaw and directed phenomenal growth and change within CSF. When she took over the helm in 2010, CSF was awarding scholarships of \$1,500 per year for 4 years and in that year CSF had 45 students with total funds of \$212,180.

Today, CSF's scholarships are \$2,500 per year for 5 years with approximately 105 students in CSF's regular program, 5 students and 4-5 interns in the Grgich program, and 4 students and growing in the Radoš endowment. CSF's 120 students represent a 200% increase in students. This was all accomplished through Marijana's dedication, tenacity, strong personality and incredible organizational skills along with the support of people like you. Likewise, donors and fund raising increased including CSF's two Endowments: the Mike Grgich endowment for viticulture and the Damir Radoš endowment in memory of his mother Dragica (1918-2015) for music, arts and theater students.

All this was accomplished with an all-volunteer board and a dedicated part-time administrative assistance.

I am personally delighted to have been selected president and excited about the future of CSF. Whenever any of our Board members become overwhelmed with the task at hand, we are cheered by thinking about our students. They are an amazing group of talented young Croatians.

Joe accepting W.W. Patty Distinguished Alumni Award from University of Indiana

On June 3 2023, the National Federation of Croatian Americans Cultural Foundation (NFCACF) honored Joe at their national meeting in Washington D.C. and he received NFCACF'S first-ever Legacy Award as a Founder, President, and for his 30 years

of service. NFCACF was formed in 1993 to fight for the independence of Croatia during its war of independence from the former Yugoslavia. Since then, NFCACF has been a strong advocate in Washington D.C. to form relationships throughout the government, to advance legislation to benefit Croatia and Croatian-Americans, and to build a strong and engaged American-Croatian community. An NFCACF spokesman said, "We believe that Dr. Cindrich's achievements and recognition deserve widespread attention, as they serve as an inspiration for future generations of Croatian Americans".

Born in Western Pennsylvania, "coal mining country" near Pittsburgh, Joe's mother Agnes and father Ante "Tony" were immigrants to the United States from Lika, Croatia. Tony was a lifelong coal miner and Agnes was a homemaker and mother of seven children.

His parents instilled in him a deep love of Croatian heritage, culture and of course the

music and food.

Joe was a football star earning High School All American and All-State honors as a Tackle in Pennsylvania and was awarded full-ride football scholarships to Notre Dame and many other colleges. Deciding to stay close to home, he accepted a full ride to

the University of Pittsburgh. After the untimely death of his father, Joe returned home where

he worked in the coal mines to support his family. After Joe's mother passed away, he raised his younger brother Paul throughout high school as he promised his mother.

He joined the US Marine Corps where he served in Japan and Okinawa, and played football for the Parris Island Marines. After the military, he enrolled at Indiana University on a football scholarship where he earned his Bachelors and Master degrees in Public Health. He earned his PhD from the University of Maryland in Public Health, Safety and Transportation.

Joe then began a 22 year career in the Federal Government with executive positions in the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Social Security Administration and finally as Regional Administrator for the US Department of Transportation for the Western states and the Pacific (Region 9) in San Francisco. He led many innovative projects, testified before Congress on many occasions and brought a high level of competence and integrity to his teams. In addition, Joe was a college professor and taught at Western Illinois University, University of Maryland and San Diego State University.

Joe has been a tremendous asset to CSF. He worked closely with the founders, Branko Barbir, Bob Bronzan and Tony Udjur, bringing a level of professionalism and accountability to the organization. He was frequently the Master of Ceremonies at the annual CSF Gala. As someone with a strong and personal understanding of the power of education, Joe foresaw the importance and impact of CSF on the lives of young people for Croatia. He always asks about results: "have they become leaders and given back to Croatia?" That is still his challenge to CSF, to make sure we are developing leaders through education.

We congratulate Joe on his recent achievements and look forward to many more years of collaboration and success.


